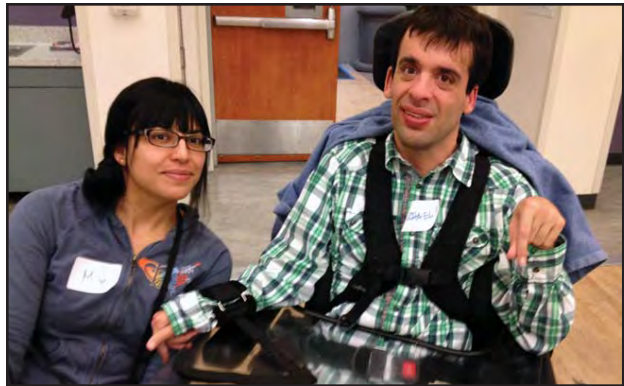




Social Services

Located at the Senior Center, Senior and Social Services staff is available Tuesday through Saturday to residents of all ages-offering assistance with information, referrals, and help on topics such as: alternative transportation, counseling, caregiver support, bereavement groups, disability programs, aging resources, low income programs & services, government benefits, homelessness, abuse reporting, health & medical resources, and others.



Staff is available via phone and e-mail and is available to meet by appointment. Staff works to ensure that people of all abilities are included, able to access services, and accepted as valued members of the community. In addition to offering a variety of recreational opportunities for people with disabilities, staff also communicates with City departments to address barriers and expressed concerns.
