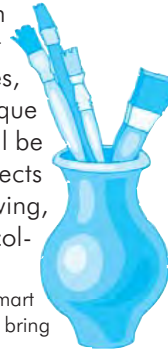

CCARP

\$47/week Resident, 2nd child \$42/ week

CCARP is a fee-based program that provides supervised recreational activities for elementary aged children (k-5) and at the Culver City Middle School. Activities include Homework time, arts and crafts, games and free play. Students from U.C.L.A. BruinCorps provide tutorial assistance at the Middle School site.

Note: The program is not offered on pupil free days and holidays. On Wednesday, if kindergarten class ends before 1:30pm the parent must make other arrangements for their child to be picked up. CCARP staff begins work at 1:30pm on Wednesdays. CCARP is closed during Winter, Spring and Summer recess. Fees must be paid by Tuesday preceding the week the child will be attending. Payments made after Tuesday will be assessed a \$26 late payment fee. No payments will be accepted after the Friday preceding the week the child will be attending.
