



## Storm Drains are for Rain...

*Did you know that anything that goes into a storm drain in the cities of Beverly Hills, Culver City and West Hollywood*

*has a direct impact on the environmental health of our local beaches and coastal waters?*

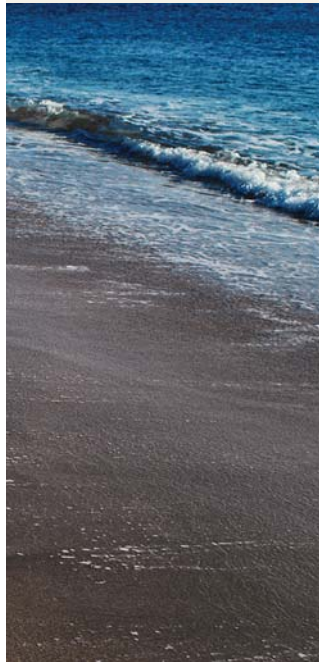
**Not Automotive Fluids** — Recycle all hazardous wastes including motor oil and filters, antifreeze, and radiator fluids, as well as household waste like paint, solvents and caustic cleaners.

**Not Pet Waste** — Pick up after your dog every time. Animal waste left on the ground washes down storm drains and contaminates local beaches and the ocean.

**Not Yard Waste** — Bag, compost or recycle grass, tree limbs, leaves and other yard wastes. Don't rake, blow, or hose yard waste into the gutter. Soggy yard waste is a major contributor to clogged storm drains, and street and neighborhood flooding.

**Not Fertilizer or Pesticides** — Reduce pesticide and fertilizer use during wet weather. More is not better — excessive use of fungicides, insecticides, and fertilizers contribute to stormwater pollution with the release of toxic and synthetic chemicals.

**Not Litter** — Do not throw litter, cigarette butts and other debris into the street. Trash in the gutter flows directly to local beaches and can clog storm drains causing flooding.

## Used Motor Oil and Filters

The Cities of Beverly Hills, Culver City and West Hollywood encourage all their residents to recycle their used motor oil and filters. In the Westside it's quick and it's easy to do. Just refer to the maps below to find the Certified Used Oil Collection Center nearest you.

## Tips for Recycling Used Motor Oil and Oil Filters

Please call the FREE Collection Center nearest you to verify hours of operation and quantities accepted. Used motor oil recyclers are eligible for a \$.16 per gallon rebate.

### CONTAMINATED OIL IS NOT ACCEPTED!

Carry oil in clean, non-breakable containers, no metal containers, please. Place oil filters in a plastic bag to prevent leaks.

Do not mix oil with any other chemicals or materials including bleach, paint, solvents, water, or other automotive fluids.

Maximum container size — 5 gallons.

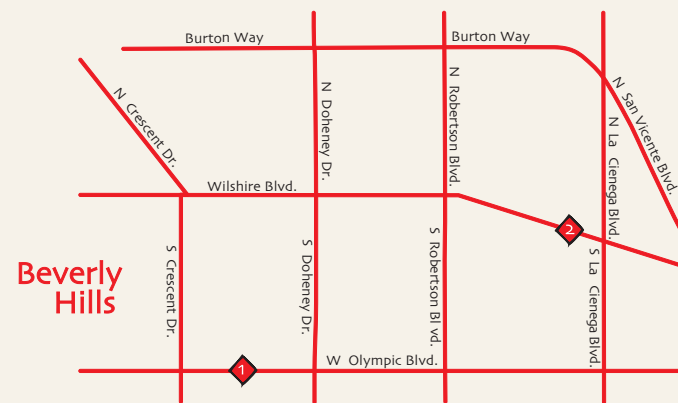
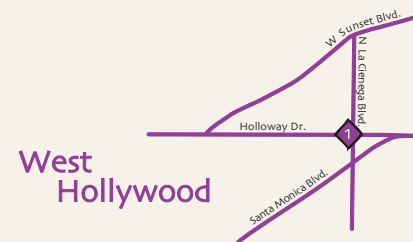
