The Blue Container (RECYCLABLES)

*The following types of materials should be placed
in the **BLUE RECYCLING** container:*




-  **CARDBOARD** (please flatten or collapse boxes before placing them in your container)




-  **NEWSPAPERS** (newspaper and inserts)




-  **CLEAN MIXED PAPER** (magazines, junk mail, office & computer paper, phone books, cereal and food boxes w/o liners, cardboard egg cartons)




-  **METAL CANS** (aluminum cans, tin or steel food & beverage cans, pet food cans, empty aerosol cans, clean foil & pie plates, wire hangers)



-  **GLASS CONTAINERS** (food jars, beverage bottles — rinse before recycling)



-  **PLASTIC** (PET 1-5, milk, water jugs, detergent, soap or shampoo bottles)



Rule of thumb: IF IT'S NOT OOHEY, GOOEY OR CHEWY, THEN IT CAN BE PLACED IN THE RECYCLING BIN.

BULKY ITEM PICK-UP

Each calendar year Environmental Programs and Operations offers two (2) free bulky item pickups to homes that utilize the automated containers (blue, black, green). Additional collections within the same year are subject to a service fee. Typical large or bulky items include appliances, furniture, area rugs, water heaters, etc. Excluded items include construction materials, concrete and asphalt, dirt, tires, or hazardous waste items such as paint, oil, or solvents. Call customer server to schedule a pickup.
