What does Culver City recycle?

Non-collection days

Refuse and recycling is not collected on January 1 and December 25. Collection routes will be adjusted to pickup the missed days and continue the following day for these weeks only.

What can residents recycle?

The Blue Container **RECYCLABLES**

The following types of materials can be placed in the Culver City BLUE RECYCLING container:



METAL CANS - aluminum cans, tin, steel food containers, empty aerosol cans, clean foil, pie plates, and wire hangers. For more information on recycling cans, please visit: <http://earth911.org/blog/category/recycling/aluminum-can-recycling>



GLASS CONTAINERS - food jars, beverage bottles, colored glass bottles.
Whenever possible, please rinse before depositing into the blue container.



PLASTIC - PET 1-5, milk jugs, water jugs, and assorted plastic drink bottles,
liquid soap detergent bottles and shampoo bottles



CLEAN MIXED PAPER - Newsprint papers, newspaper and inserts, writing
paper, office & computer paper, magazines, catalogues and telephone
directories, junk mail, greeting cards, envelopes, and phone books,

CARDBOARD - Cereal boxes, food boxes, cardboard egg cartons, packaging
and all general boxes are acceptable. To conserve space, flatten or collapse
boxes before placing them in the container
