How do I Register to Vote?

Registering to vote is a very easy process and takes less than 5 minutes to complete! The California Secretary of State provides important information regarding voter registration at the following link:

You may obtain a voter registration card by visiting the City Clerk's Office located on the First Floor of City Hall (9770 Culver Boulevard – Culver City, CA 90232) during normal business hours (7:30 AM to 5:30 PM Monday through Friday – City Hall is closed alternate Fridays. City Hall is closed on Friday, January 13, 2012). Voter Registration Forms are available at the counter.

IMPORTANT – Voter Registration Cards MUST be postmarked no later than 15 days prior to an election to be valid. For the April 10, 2012 General Municipal Election, March 26, 2012 is the postmark deadline!
