That a General Municipal Election will be held in the City of Culver City on Tuesday, April 10, 2012 for the following Officers and Measure:

For the following Measure

Measure X:

To preserve funding of essential general city services including: public safety; street/park maintenance; senior services; job creation; business development; shall Culver City increase the existing Transient Occupancy Tax, ("hotel room tax"), charged only to persons who occupy hotel/motel rooms in Culver City, from 12% to 14% on July 1, 2012, with expenditures approved through general fund budgets adopted in open public hearings, subject to annual audits?

The nomination period of these offices begins on Monday, December 19, 2011 and closes on Tuesday, January 17, 2012 at 5:30 PM.

If nomination papers for an incumbent officer of the City are not filed by Tuesday, January 17, 2012 at 5:30 PM, the voters shall have until Monday, January 23, 2012 at 5:30 PM to nominate candidates other than the person(s) who are the incumbents on Tuesday, January 17, 2012 for that incumbent's elective office. This extension is not applicable where there is no incumbent eligible to be elected.

If no one or only one person is nominated for an elective office, appointment to the elective office may be made as prescribed by Section 10229 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

The polls will be open between the hours of 7:00 AM and 8:00 PM.
