- WHO:** The Voters of the City of Culver City
- WHAT:** The Municipal Election of April 13, 2010
- WHERE:** Your Culver City Polling Place or via Vote by Mail Ballot
- WHEN:** Tuesday, April 13, 2010  
Polls Open at 7:00 AM and Close at 8:00 PM
- WHY:** The City Charter provides that there shall be an election in our City on the second Tuesday of April of each even numbered year. On April 13, 2010, there shall be an election in Culver City to choose two Members of the City Council.
- Info:** You must be a citizen of the United States, a resident of Culver City who has reached the age of 18 on the day of the election, and be registered in order to vote. Registration is a quick, easy process! More information on registration, [click here](#).

Interested in running for office? The candidate filing period begins at 7:30 AM on Monday, December 21, 2009 and continues until the close of business (5:30 PM) on Tuesday, January 19, 2010.

The deadlines for filing are set by State Law. If you are interested in running for office, please contact the City Clerk's Office EARLY in the filing period. Waiting until the final day may not allow enough time for prospective candidates to complete the required documents.

## Registering to Vote

- WHO:** Persons interested in Voting in the Upcoming April 2010 Election
- WHAT:** The Voting Registration Process
- WHERE:** Online, by Mail, or in Person
- WHEN:** To vote in the Municipal Election on April 13, 2010 you must register no later than 15 days before the election (Registration applications must be **POSTMARKED** no later than **March 29, 2010**). Early registration is recommended!
- WHY:** Federal and State Law provide that persons eligible to vote in an election be registered to vote.
- INFO:** Registering to vote is quick and easy. You can register to vote in three ways:
- ONLINE:** The California Secretary of State's Office provides information online at [http://www.sos.ca.gov/elections/elections\\_vr.htm](http://www.sos.ca.gov/elections/elections_vr.htm). Follow the instructions provided.
- MAIL:** You may request a registration form via mail by sending your request to City Clerk's Office 9770 Culver Boulevard Culver City, CA 90230.
