NOTICE OF IMMINENT CONSTRUCTION

La Ballona Safe Routes to School Project, PL-006, Federal Project No. ATPL 5240(034)

This is to advise you that a construction contract for the La Ballona Safe Routes to School Project has been awarded for a Public Works improvement project in your area. The Project will install a number of traffic safety improvements in the neighborhood surrounding La Ballona Elementary School to make it safer and more comfortable to walk and bike to school. Proposed improvements include:

- Curb extensions at intersections to shorten pedestrian crossing distances
- New ADA ramps to make it easier to cross the street in a wheelchair or with a stroller
- New high-visibility crosswalks
- New controlled intersections with median refuge islands on Washington Blvd.
- New street trees and pedestrian-scale lighting
- A new protected bike lane on Elenda Street between Culver Blvd. and Washington Blvd.
- Two new pedestrian crossing traffic signals at Prospect Avenue/Washington Boulevard and Elenda Street/Washington Boulevard

The work is scheduled to begin on Monday, August 24, 2020 and be completed by early Summer 2021.
The working hours are between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

The Contractor will provide advance notification to the immediate affected businesses and residents with the specific dates of construction on your particular streets. Regular project updates can be found on City's website.

Due to the construction, you may experience temporary sidewalk and curb ramp closures, loss of possible street parking, construction noise, dust, etc., even though every effort will be made by the City and the Contractor to minimize these inconveniences. Your patience and cooperation in observing all traffic controls, parking restrictions and traffic control workers will be sincerely appreciated and will help in expediting construction of the project.

If this notice is delivered to a multi-unit complex, we request the manager notify all occupants personally or via conspicuous posting in the mail delivery area.
