3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
4 CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, SUPPORTING VISION ZERO
5 INITIATIVE AND OTHER PROGRAMS OR INITIATIVES TO
6 MAKE SAFETY A TOP PRIORITY FOR TRANSPORTATION
PROJECTS AND POLICY FORMULATION.

7 WHEREAS, the life and health of Culver City's residents is a top priority
8 for the City Council's; and

9 WHEREAS, each year more than 30,000 people are killed on streets in
10 the United States in traffic collisions; and

11
12 WHEREAS, traffic fatalities in America hit a seven-year high in 2015 and
13 are estimated to have exceeded 35,000 people, with pedestrians and cyclists
14 accounting for a disproportionate share; and

15 WHEREAS, the Centers for Disease Control recently indicated that
16 America's traffic death rate per person is about double the average of peer nations; and

17
18 WHEREAS, Vision Zero is a comprehensive strategy to eliminate all traffic
19 fatalities and severe injuries using a multi-disciplinary approach, including education,
20 enforcement and engineering measures; and

21 WHEREAS, a core principal of Vision Zero is that traffic deaths are
22 preventable and unacceptable; and

24 WHEREAS, cities across the world have adopted and implemented Vision
25 Zero strategies and successfully reduced traffic fatalities and severe injuries occurring
26 on streets and highways; and

1 WHEREAS safe, reliable, and efficient transportation systems are
2 essential foundations for thriving cities.


3 WHEREAS, Culver City strives to provide Safe Routes to Schools to
4 thousands of school children every year; and

5 WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Transportation, through the Mayors'
6 Challenge for Safer People, Safer Streets, has challenged Mayors to take significant
7 action on improving the safety of transportation networks for pedestrians and bicyclists
8 of all ages and abilities, and the City of Culver City accepted that challenge.


9 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City DOES
