## NOTICE TO VOTERS OF DATE AFTER WHICH NO ARGUMENTS FOR OR AGAINST ONE CITY MEASURE MAY BE SUBMITTED TO THE CITY CLERK

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the following measure will be voted on at the Special Municipal Election to be held in the City of Culver City and consolidated with the State Primary Election on **Tuesday, March 3, 2020.** 

Measure:	
"CONTINUATION OF CITY SERVICES TRANSACTIONS AND USE TAX. Shall the measure to maintain 911 emergency response services by retaining firefighters/ police officers/ paramedics; addressing homelessness; fixing potholes/streets; maintaining storm drains, parks, after-school programs, senior services, and other general fund services, by continuing the voter approved one-half cent sales tax, generating approximately 9.8 million dollars annually, until	YES
March 31, 2033, requiring independent annual audits, all funds used locally, with no tax rate increase, be adopted?"	NO

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that pursuant to Section 11 of City Council Resolution No. 2019-R082, and Section 9280 of the Elections Code, the impartial analyses of said measures prepared by the City Attorney shall be filed in the office of the City Clerk not later than <u>5:30 p.m.</u> <u>Friday, December 13, 2019.</u>

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that pursuant to Section 9282(b) of the Elections Code, any and all direct arguments for and against the measure shall be filed in the office of the City Clerk not later than <u>5:30 p.m., Friday, December 13, 2019</u>. All arguments shall be accompanied by the information set forth in Section 9283 of the Elections Code. Written argument(s) shall not exceed 300 words in length. City Council has authorized two members of the City Council to prepare written arguments in support of both measures for approval by the entire City Council for filing with the City Clerk.

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that, pursuant to Elections Code Section 9287, in the event more than one argument for or more than one argument against the initiative is submitted to the City Clerk within the time prescribed, the City Clerk must select one of the arguments in favor and one of the arguments against the measures for printing and distribution to the voters. In selecting each of the arguments, the City Clerk must give preference and priority, in the order named, to the arguments of the following:

- The legislative body, or member(s) of the legislative body authorized by that body
- The individual voter, or bona fide association of citizens, or combination of voters and associations, who are the bona fide sponsors or proponents of the measures
- · Bona fide associations of citizens; and
- Individual voters who are eligible to vote on the measures

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN,** pursuant to Section 9286 of the Elections Code, that any change to or withdrawal of any ballot argument for or against the above measures must be filed in the Office of the City Clerk not later than **5:30 p.m., Friday, December 13, 2019.** 

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that any impartial analysis or direct arguments filed under the authority of the Elections Code will be available for public examination during regular office hours in the office of the City Clerk for not less than 10 calendar days from the deadline for the filing of the arguments and analysis (**December 14, 2019 through December 23, 2019.**)

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN,** pursuant to Section 9285 of the Elections Code, that any written rebuttal argument for or against the above measures shall not exceed 250 words in length and must be filed in the Office of the City Clerk not later than <u>5:30 p.m., Monday, December 23, 2019.</u>

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that any rebuttal argument filed under the authority of Section 9285 of the Elections Code will be available for public examination during regular office hours in the office of the City of Culver City for not less than 10 calendar days from the deadline for the filing of the arguments and analysis. (**December 24, 2019 through January 2, 2020.**)
