3	RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY STANDING WITH UKRAINE AND CONDEMNING THE RUSSIAN INVASION OF UKRAINE
4	
5	WHEREAS, the Act of Declaration of Independence of Ukraine was adopted
6	by the Ukrainian parliament on August 24, 1991; and
7	WHEREAS, the Act was adopted in the aftermath of the coup attempt in the
8	Soviet Union on August 19, 1991, when hardline Communist leaders attempted to restore
9 10	central Communist party control over the USSR; and
11	WHEREAS, on February 24, 2022, Russian forces launched an unprovoked,
12	full-scale invasion of Ukraine, a peaceful, independent country; and
13	WHEREAS, the United Nations Human Rights Council reports that Russia's
14	invasion has damaged and destroyed schools, hospitals, radio stations, and homes, killing
15	and injuring civilians, including children; and
16	WHEREAS, many nations, including the United States and its European allies,
17	have condemned in the strongest language this horrifying attack and outright war of
18	aggression on Ukraine and its citizens in an attempt to overthrow the democracy and
19	occupy Ukraine; and
20	WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Treasury, pursuant to various Executive
21	Orders, imposed sanctions against Russia for its harmful foreign activities, including
22	violating well-established principles of international law such as respect for the sovereignty
23 24	and territorial integrity of other states.
25	WHEREAS, over 112,000 Ukrainians and Americans of Ukrainian descent call
26	California home; and

1	WHEREAS, Culver City shares with our partners and allies, unity of purpose,
2	resolve, and determination to hold Russia accountable for its aggression, particularly those
3	responsible for this war of choice; and
4	WHEREAS, our hearts go out to the innocent victims of this unfounded and
5	unnecessary war, including the families and children who have been killed and injured or
6	who are fleeing their homeland of Ukraine to escape Russia's unprovoked attack; and
7	WHEREAS, it is widely reported by the media that there is a significant
8	segment of the Russian population expressing their opposition to this war and currently
9	being detained by the police for publicly expressing their views and facing the possibility of
10 11	harsh prison terms.
12	NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, California,
13	DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, as follows:
14	The City of Culver City condemns the Russian attack on Ukraine and stands
15	with the United States and its allies, President Joseph Biden, the people of Ukraine, all the
16	people of Russia who are opposing this war while facing political persecution, and Ukrainian
17	President Volodymyr Zelenskyy in opposition to this war.
