
























Phase I (Initial)

- Installing art & interpretive signage
- Opening existing gateways
- Native plant education
- Engaging with local community groups & businesses

Phase II (Intermediate)

- ❖ Opening pocket parks → storytelling
- Installing lighting
- Terracing in right-of-way or pilot project in channel
- Open new access points
- Small-scale water capture




LA River proposed terracing



Phase III (Long-term)

- Path extension
- Widespread terracing and re-configuration
- Flood mitigation and large-scale water capture
- Broader network of transportation elements adjacent to Creek
- Possible zoning adjustments & city property re-location
