Paid Internship Program (PIP)

- Our mission: Promotion of independence and full integration into community life through competitive integrated employment of individuals with developmental disabilities.
- ▶ Paid Internship Program (PIP) opportunity to increase vocational skills and abilities of individuals with developmental disabilities.

Goals:

- Acquisition of experience and skills for future paid employment.
- Internship itself to lead to a full or part time paid employment in the same job.

PIP - Funding

- The maximum funding for payment of an internship is \$10,400 per year, per individual.
- Multiple paid internships may be possible, as determined through the IPP process.
- Internship funds may be available for individuals for a variety of models, including self-employment enterprises and apprenticeships, and other business opportunities that can lead to future paid employment.
- All businesses participating in the Paid Internship program must operate in Compliance with California State laws.

PIP - Guidelines

- Internship wages will be at least state or local minimum wage.
- Individuals 18-22 years of age who are in school and interested in participating in the paid internship program may be eligible, however Regional Centers must comply with WIC Section 4648.55 (cannot be used while school is in session)
- Service Provider must have approved addendum to program design describing services and supports created to assist individuals in achieving personcentered goal of paid internships.
- ► There is **no minimum** or **maximum hour** requirement; however there is a cap on funding.

PIP - Benefits for Employers

- Provides employers access to a pool of motivated individuals who bring fresh thinking and innovation and diversity to their workplace.
- No cost to the employer up to \$10,400 per year, per individual. Cost that are covered by the reimbursement include: wages, payroll costs, and employer mandated costs such as insurance and liability.
