Reason why project is Exempt (brief): There are no potentially significant adverse impacts on the environment and the project has been determined to be Categorically Exempt under Section 15332, Class 32 In-fi Development Project, because the proposed project, as described above, is consistent with the General Plan Land Use Designation and corresponding Zone; is located within Culve City surrounded by urban uses, and has no value as a habitat for endangered, rare, of threatened species as it is currently developed with a two-story commercial structure community garden, and improvements consistent with adjacent development. Based on the scope and size, the Project will not have significant traffic impacts or peak hour trips exceeding established thresholds; potential noise and air quality impacts generated by the Project will be within established thresholds; implementation of public works storm water.
