Dear Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Commission members,

The following is the schedule of the upcoming Annual La Ballona Creek Bike Path (LBCBP) Maintenance Program.

First Note: We generally perform this duty in the summer months when Culver City schools are out of session.

However, due to extreme weather conditions this past winter and a shortage of budgeted staff members we needed to concentrate most of our time in maintaining the City's public right of way, in addition to scheduling our tree trimming contractor, West Coast Arborist (WCA) with the multitude of tree failure we experienced throughout the City.

I agree that the LBCBP is an integral part of our right of way, but we were only able to address emergency situations as they arose.

We are scheduling the LBCBP maintenance for the week December 18th through the 22nd 2023. Culver City schools will be on holiday break this week.

Our plan is to schedule the Graffiti abatement, Weed abatement, Tree trimming by WCA and Surface maintenance in three sections along LBCBP, from the Eastside gate of Sepulveda BI. to the end at Syd Kronenthal Park/National BI. gate. These sections of the bike path will be closed from 8:00am to 4:00pm on the following dates.

- Syd Kronenthal Park/National BI. gate to Duquesne Ave. gate, including the Higuera St. gate on Monday, 12/18 and Tuesday 12/19.
- Duquesne Ave. gate to the Eastside gate of Overland Ave. including the Jackson Ave. gate on Wednesday, 12/20 and Thursday, 12/21.
- the Westside gate of Overland Ave. to the Eastside gate of Sepulveda BI. on Friday, 12/22.

Large notification signs will be posted 1 week in advance of the work at each gate, with the specific section closure schedule.

I look forward to meeting with you all on Thursday night.
