

Parking Meters in Culver City

- Public Works operates 1,990 on-street parking meters
- Additional 500 meters planned for 2024
- Average revenue \$82,000/month

Commercial Areas	783	\$0.25
Outside of Downtown	1,079	\$1.00
Downtown District	128	\$1.50

City parking garages are free for the first hour, then \$1.00 for each 30 minutes with a \$12 maximum per day.
