Charter Amendment:

Council Resignation Waiting Period To Run Again

City of Culver City November 8, 2016 Special Municipal Election

Shall Section 602 of the Charter of the City of Culver City be amended to provide for the ineligibility of a person who has resigned from the City Council to run for the Office of City Council Member for a period of two years from the date of such resignation, as follows (additions indicated by <u>underlined</u> text):

SECTION 602. ELIGIBILITY.

Only residents of the City who are lawfully registered voters of the City shall be eligible to hold an elective City office. Candidates for election to any such office must have been lawfully registered voters of the City for the 30 days immediately preceding the filing of their nomination papers.

<u>Residents who have resigned from an elective City office shall not</u> <u>be eligible to hold an elective City office nor be eligible for candidacy for</u> <u>election until two years have elapsed from the date of resignation.</u>
