Spayed/Neutered Dog \$ 25.00

Unaltered Dog \$ 50.00

All dogs must be spayed or neutered. Exemptions from this requirement are available only for health reasons, for law enforcement or service dogs, and for qualifying competition dogs. Documentation is required.

Late Fee \$ 25.00

A late fee of \$25 will be added to licenses not renewed by the first of the month following their prior license expiration and to new licenses not purchased within 30 days of dog ownership or residency in Culver City.

Spayed/Neutered Cat (Voluntary) \$ 10.00

Unaltered Cat (Voluntary) \$ 20.00

To License Your Pet by Mail: Complete this application, Include your pet's microchip number, Enclose a copy of your pet's current rabies vaccination certificate, Enclose proof of spay/neuter if it is not indicated on the rabies certificate, Make your check or money order payable to City of Culver City, **Mail to: Culver City Dog Licensing, c/o PetData, PO Box 141929, Irving, TX 75014.**

Paperwork: A current rabies vaccination certificate, microchip number and proof of spay/neuter are required to license your pet. Please submit legible copies of your paperwork. Documents will not be returned.

License Term: Licenses will expire one year from date of issue for the first license. Subsequent licenses will expire one year from the expiration of the previous license.
