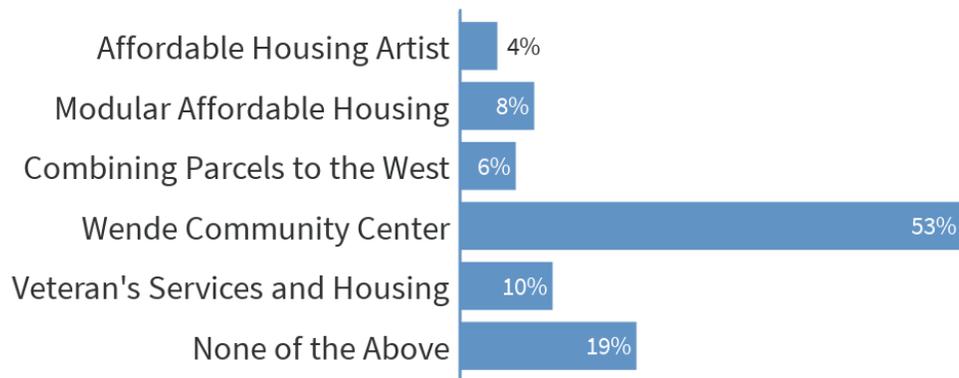


**Summary of Community Input from  
September 24, 2019 City of Culver City Community Meeting on 10858 Culver Boulevard**

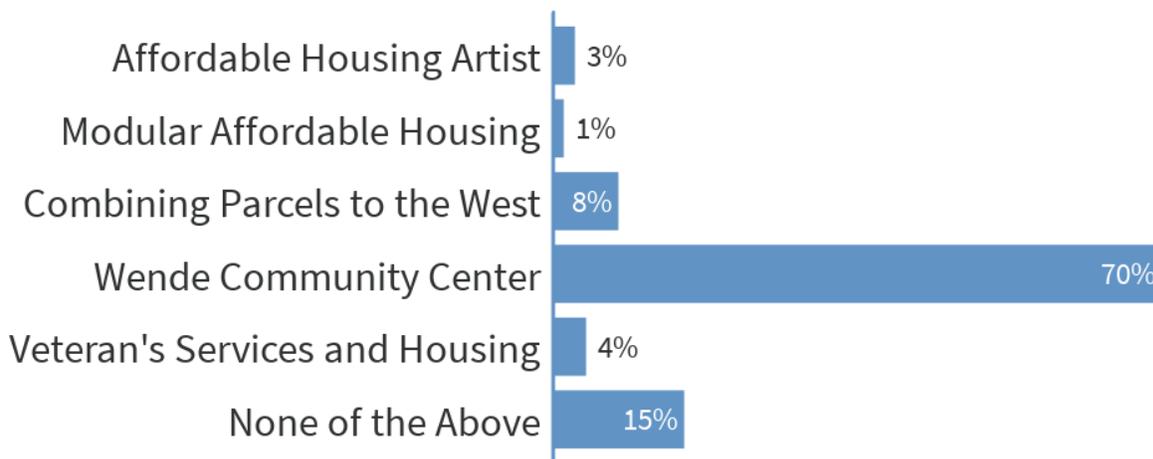
After a discussion of the five potential opportunities for future use of 10858 Culver Boulevard that were identified at the July 8 City Council meeting, participants at the September 24, 2019 meeting were asked to select **all of the uses they would find acceptable** at the site. Participants could select more than one acceptable use. If none of the uses would be acceptable, participants could select “None of the Above.” *(Note that the graphic has been adjusted from the one displayed at the meeting because one or more meeting participants entered multiple votes for the same use. The below graphic has been adjusted to limit to a maximum of one the number of responses per person for each of the acceptable use options.)*

**Acceptable Uses - Adjusted**



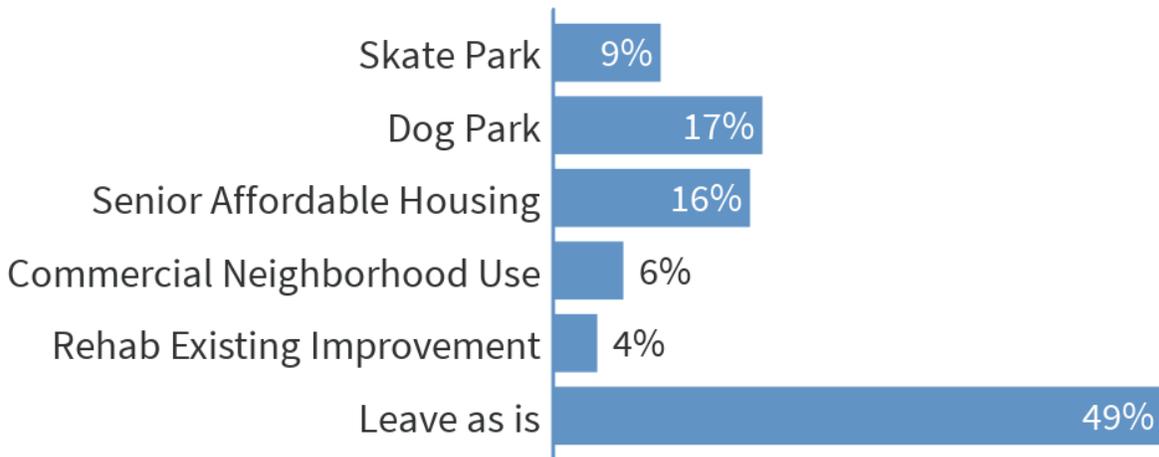
A second poll was administered to determine participant’s **preferred use** at the site. Participants were asked to select which use would be their “first choice.” If none of the options were preferred, participants could select “None of the Above.”

**Potential Uses - First Choice**



During the breakout session, participants were asked to brainstorm and let staff know if there were **other uses – not presented in the previous polls – that should be considered**. Six uses were suggested and participants were asked to select **all of the uses they would find acceptable at the site**. Participants could select more than one option. If none of the uses would be acceptable, participants could select “Leave as is.”

## Other Uses For Consideration



At the conclusion of the meeting, participants were asked to participate in a group brainstorm about what the site should be and/or other uses that may not have been considered in the previous polls. Meeting participants were then asked to submit **words that represented the other ideas**. Words that were most frequently submitted appear larger and bolder in the word cloud.
