The City of Culver City provides a third-party reporting hotline for employees and the public to anonymously report any of the following incidents:

Fraud, Waste and Abuse of City resources

- Theft of City resources (e.g., cash, equipment, supplies or materials)
- Record falsification
- Payroll fraud or time abuse
- Kickbacks or bribes
- Intentional misuse of City equipment or property
- Contractor fraud
- Gross mismanagement of resources, including careless expenditures
- Gross disregard of policy and/or procedural controls



Please do not use this program to report grievable labor issues or employee misconduct, which should be reported to Human Resources. Matters of threat to a person should be reported to the Police Department by calling 911.
